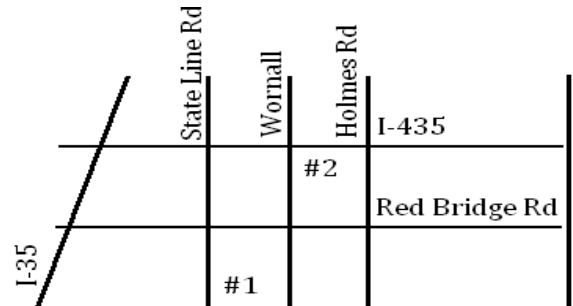

2 LEVELS OFFERED FOR MOUNTAIN DULCIMER – SEE BACK FOR CLASS DESCRIPTION

Linda's Class – Advancing Beginner to Advanced – (anyone wanting a “refresher” class)

This session will include tunes of different styles to build repertoire while also offering techniques to improve skills in playing embellishments and accompaniments on the Hammered Dulcimer. Participants should be familiar with tuning their instruments; however, the workshop is open to both “readers” and “by ear” players. The class will offer BASIC MELODY, EMBELLISHED VERSION/S and BACK-UP or ACCOMPANIMENTS for each title; playing part songs will be included (as time permits). Come join us for a day of Music and Fun!!

Suggested items to bring to the workshop: *Tuner *Pencil

Elaine's Class – Advancing Beginners

This session will be geared towards the advancing beginner and those looking to improve basic skills on the dulcimer. The participant should already be able to play a few songs on the dulcimer and understand simple notating and strumming concepts.

Elaine will spend the day teaching various tunes that introduce and reinforce skills such as tab reading, chording, consistent fingering, picking patterns, ear training, etc., in an effort to improve your skill level so that you feel more comfortable playing with others.

There will even be some two-part arrangements included that will include a part that is slightly more challenging yet the duet part will be quiet accessible.

Handy items to bring to class include:

- Music Stand
- Tuner
- Pencil
- Highlighter

Larry's Class – Intermediate Level and Up

This class will be geared towards the intermediate level player and beyond. Participants enrolling in this class should have a working knowledge of two and three finger chords, various strumming/picking patterns and the ability to read and understand dulcimer tablature.

Larry will teach various songs intended to enhance your repertoire and improve your playing skills. Some songs may be taught in multiple keys while some may make use of a capo. Some songs will be familiar ones while others will be new to you.

The goal will be to send you home with enough material to keep you busy for weeks, present several concepts to challenge you, and, at the same time, inspire you to become a better player.

Come with an enthusiastic attitude and open mind.

- Music Stand
- Pencil
- Highlighter
- Tuner
- Capo
- Extra Strings (just in case)
- 1 + fret (useful but certainly not necessary)
